CALL TO ORDER

- Pursuant to public notice, the meeting commenced at 10:32 a.m. with a Call to Order by Chairman Ken Haiko. Roll call was taken, and quorum established. Chair Haiko thanked Principal Tirado for hosting the board meeting.

I. PUBLIC COMMENTS

- Board Chair Ken Haiko called for public comments. There were none.

II. SCHOOL PRESENTATION

- Students from Renaissance Charter School at Goldenrod performed for the board celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month.

III. ADMINISTRATIVE

Approval of September 7, 2022, Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Board Meeting Minutes

- The board reviewed the September 7, 2022, Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Board Meeting minutes.

MOTION: Motion was made by Billie Miller and seconded by Dennis Clark to approve the September 7, 2022, Renaissance Charter School, Inc. Board Meeting Minutes, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously. (6-0)

IV. CSUSA REPORTS

State Director Update

- Dr. Eddie Ruiz shared with the board updates of each school after Hurricane Ian thanking those functional support teams that assisted in preparing for the hurricane as well as the aftermath. There was minor damage to some of the buildings and facilities is already in process with the minor repairs. Dr. Ruiz updated the board on the collaboration with the National functional departments and the State teams including IT, the deputy directors, all spearheaded by Ana Cordal in collaboration.

MOTION: Motion was made by Paul Sallarulo and seconded by Tom Wheeler to accept the CSUSA State Director's Report, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

FY23 TSIA Review

- The board reviewed the FY23 TSIA plans submitted to the FL DOE and is currently under review for approval. The board discussed with Dr. Ruiz the details of the plan and the current desire to continue to increase all teacher salaries. Dr. Ruiz reviewed the base salaries of the districts as well as the impact of referendum dollars.
- Board Director Billie Miller inquired about any indication from the State as to whether there will be a recurring bucket and was answered by Dr. Ruiz.

MOTION: Motion was made by Pat Smith and seconded by Dennis Clark to approve and ratify the TSIA Allocation plans for the portfolio of schools of the Renaissance Charter School, Inc. board, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

V. FINANCIALS

FY22 Palm Beach County Schools Budget Amendment

- The board reviewed the FY22 Unaudited Financials at the September board meeting and approved at that time, however, the motion at that time was approval of the FY22 Unaudited Financials as a group. The School District of Palm Beach County prefers an amendment specific to the schools as a budget amendment. The content is the same as the one presented and approved by the board in September, but in a different format.

MOTION: Motion was made by Pat Smith and seconded by Dennis Clark to reaffirm the board's approval of the FY22 amended budgets for the following schools: Renaissance Charter School at Central Palm, Renaissance Charter School at Cypress, Renaissance Charter School at Summit, Renaissance Charter School at Wellington, and Renaissance Charter School at West Palm Beach in Palm Beach County for Renaissance Charter School, Inc., as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

VI. OLD BUSINESS

Charter Renewal Updates

- The board reviewed renewal applications of Four Corners Upper School, Renaissance Charter School at Poinciana, and Renaissance Charter School at St. Lucie.

MOTION: Motion was made by Billie Miller and seconded by Pat Smith to accept the renewal applications for Four Corners Upper School, Renaissance Charter School at Poinciana, and Renaissance Charter School at St. Lucie, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

Duval Charter School at Scholars' School Improvement Plan

- The board reviewed Duval Charter School at Scholars' School Improvement Plan due to the district on October 18, 2022, with Area 5 Deputy Director Christina Hamlin and outlined the IPAAS (Instructional Plan for Academic Accountability and Support) initiatives currently being implemented as well as the additional support in reviewing the standards, student data analysis, as well as instructional support.

MOTION: Motion was made by Dennis Clark and seconded by Tom Wheeler to approve the Duval Charter School at Scholars' School Improvement Plan, as presented. Motion was approved unanimously.

Renaissance Charter School at Tradition– HVAC Proposal Review
