school choice. HB1 for the upcoming legislative session focuses on minors and the use of social media.
Increase in teacher pay is included in the new education budget. FEFP was in increased to \$8959 per
student.

 Academy, changes in leadership at the deputy level and principals, school grades are due at the end of
 the summer.
- Dr. Ruiz thanked the board for attending graduation he thanked the principals and staff who work on graduations across the network.
